

## Linux Ubuntu keyboard shortcuts

<b>Ctrl + C</b>	Copy highlighted text or some object to the clipboard.
<b>Ctrl + V</b>	Paste copied text or some object from the clipboard.
<b>Ctrl + X</b>	Cut highlighted text, image, or some other object.
<b>Ctrl + S</b>	Save the currently opened file.
<b>Ctrl + Z</b>	Undo the last action.
<b>Ctrl + Y</b>	Redo the last action.
<b>Ctrl + A</b>	Select all content.
<b>Delete</b>	Move selected files/folders to the Trash.
<b>Shift + Delete</b>	Permanent delete selected files/folders.
<b>Ctrl + F5</b>	Reload desktop/folder.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + T</b>	Launch Terminal.
<b>Super + L</b>	Lock screen.
<b>F11</b>	Toggle Fullscreen.
<b>Ctrl + Q</b>	Quit the application in focus.
<b>Alt + F4</b>	Close the window in focus.
<b>Alt + F10</b>	Maximize or minimize the window in focus.
<b>Super + D</b>	Minimize all windows to show desktop.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + D</b>	Minimize all windows to show desktop.
<b>Super + Arrow keys</b>	Snap the window in focus to a border.
<b>Alt + Space</b>	Active the menu for window in focus.
<b>PrtSc</b>	Take a screenshot interactively.
<b>Alt + PrtSc</b>	Take a screenshot of the window in focus.
<b>Shift + PrtSc</b>	Take a screenshot of an entire screen.
<b>Super</b>	Enter the Activities Overview.
<b>Alt + Tab</b>	Cycle between running applications.
<b>Alt + Shift + Tab</b>	Cycle between running applications - opposite direction.
<b>Alt + ; (english keyboard Alt + ')</b>	Cycle between windows of the application.
<b>Super + Tab</b>	Cycle between running applications.
<b>Super + Shift + Tab</b>	Cycle between running applications - opposite direction.
<b>Super + ; (english keyboard Alt + ')</b>	Cycle between windows of the application in focus.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + Arrow keys</b>	Switch between workspaces.
<b>Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Left or Right Arrow</b>	Move the window in focus to the workspace on the left or right.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + F1 to F6</b>	Switch to a virtual console.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + F7</b>	Switch to the first graphical terminal.
